2 CONNECTOR SETUP

2.1 DocuSign Configuration

Pre-requisites for API-based integration with DocuSign:

- DocuSign API-based account: Business Pro or Enterprise Pro. If you need a new account, please contact us at info@qtecx.com.au to provide you with a competitive pricing.
- DocuSign Developer account ready to configure

If you already have an API-based DocuSign account, you need to create a DocuSign Developer account [here](#) using your DocuSign account user credentials.

Once you have logged in to the DocuSign Developer account, go to **Settings** (top bar) and the click **Apps and Keys** on the left menu bar.

2.1.1 Setting up DocuSign Developer Account

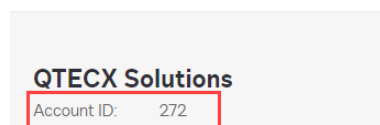
If you already have a DocuSign Developer account, skip this step and go to the next one.

Create a DocuSign Developer account [here](#) using your DocuSign account user credentials.

Once your account is ready, log in to the Developer account.

Copy the DocuSign Account ID from top left and save it somewhere safe. You will need to enter this in Creatio later.

Click **Settings** (top bar)

Click **Apps and Keys** on the left menu bar.

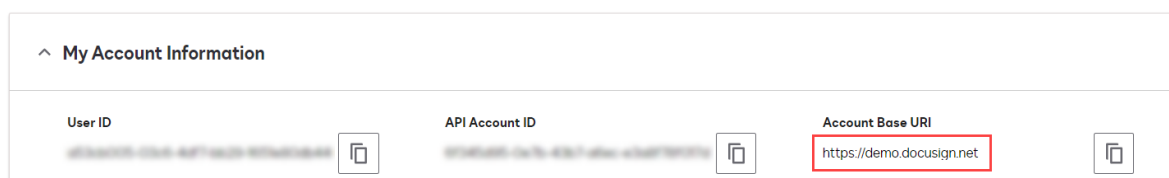
Copy the Account Base URI and save it somewhere safe. You will need to enter this in Creatio later.

When building a DocuSign integration, you must first create an app and integration key. This key is required to call any DocuSign API, either directly or by using an SDK.

Create apps and keys manually or edit keys created automatically for you by [Quickstart](#).

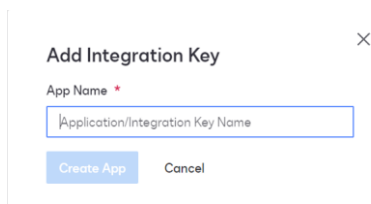

Click **Add App and Integration Key**

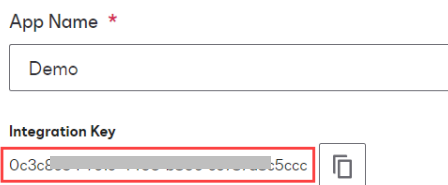
Write App Name (e.g. Creatio) and click Create App

Authentication Method for your App

Authorization Code Grant

Used for integrations where each user logs in individually and requires a one-time consent for the app to use their account.

- Require Proof Key for Code Exchange (PKCE) **RECOMMENDED**
Requires all requests to include a code verifier and code challenge, which protects your app against malicious attacks.

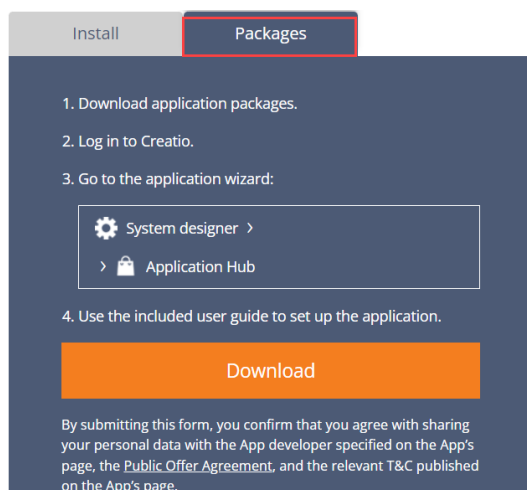
2.2 Creatio Configuration

2.2.1 Install the QTECX Solutions DocuSign Connector in Creatio

Follow these steps to set up your Creatio instance:

Download the Connector package files from [this link](#).

Click INSTALL button on the main banner. Go to Package tab and download the package files.



Go to Settings (top right gear icon)

Go to **Application Hub**

Click **New application**

Select **INSTALL FROM FILE** option

Click **SELECT FILE**

Select the downloaded package file and click Open

Creatio will install the Connector and show a message when completed.

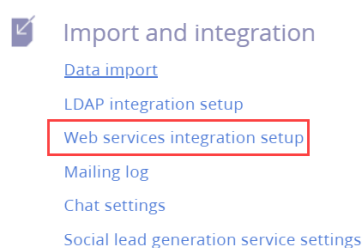
If it is successful, go to the next step.

2.2.2 Setting up Creatio – Web services

Go to Settings (top right gear icon)

Select **Web services integration setup**



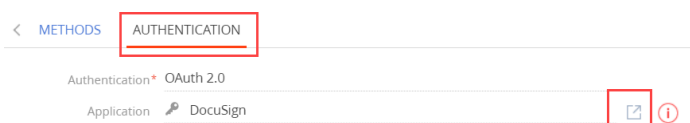
Click **QTECX DocuSign**.

Click **OK** if you get a popup box like this:

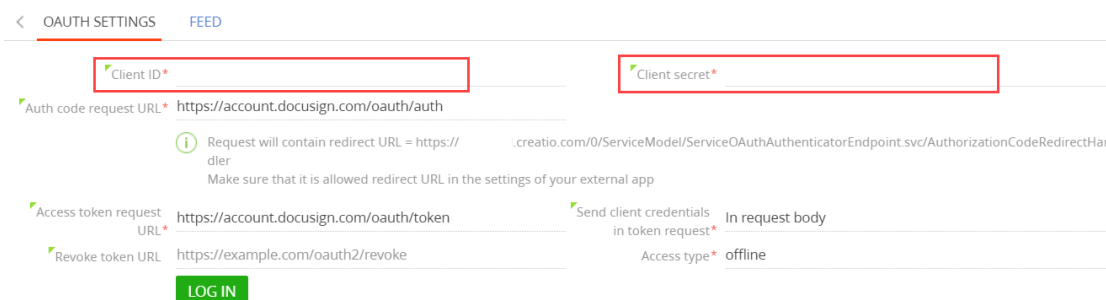

2.2.4 Setting up Creatio – Operation permissions

Go to Settings (top right gear icon)

Select **Operation permissions**

Filter on DocuSign and click on the permission for Opportunity.

To enable the button in the Contracts section, select the permission for Contracts section and add users as shown above.

Once the users have been added, these users will need to log off and log on to see the button in the Opportunities sections

Make sure users that should work with DocuSign requests have the allocated DocuSign Connector for Creatio license.

Your Connector is ready to be used by users.

3 USING DOCUSIGN CONNECTOR FEATURES

3.1 Create a DocuSign Request from Opportunity/Contract

Go to an Opportunity/Contract section and open a record. If the user has been given the operation permission (see Section 2.2.4 above), the user will see a SEND TO DOCUSIGN button on top right.

Click the button. This will open a DocuSign Request page

If you are not logged in to DocuSign, you will get a page where you need to click LOGIN.

You will be redirected to DocuSign to log in using your DocuSign account credentials. Then you will be back on this page where you need to click CONTINUE. Once logged in, you will not be asked to log in again.

When the DocuSign Request page opens, select an Email Template value with same name as the section you are creating the request in.

Select the signers with valid email address in the Participants detail. Check the Order (the signing order) is correct for the signers. The contacts in the Opportunity/Contracts sections are auto-filled to save your time.

In the Attachment tab, either upload a document or select an existing document.

Click SEND/SUBMIT button.

3.2 Tracking a DocuSign Request from Opportunity/Contract

This Connector automatically updates the information in real-time, without any user actions required.

Go to the section record where you created the DocuSign Request. Click on the DocuSign request in the DocuSign Requests detail. Here you will find all the necessary information to track the envelope progress.

When envelope is signed by all the signers, the signed document with Certificate of Completion (from DocuSign) will be available in Creatio in the DocuSign Request record. The signer document has “-Signed” at the end of the filename.
